SUMMARY

We are seeking a person to join our team to assist us with ensuring engagement of people with lived experience (PEERS) at our MB HIV-STBBI Collective Impact Network Event to be held November 2020

BACKGROUND

The MB HIV-STBBI Collective Impact Network (the Network) brings together a variety of stakeholders to tackle HIV and STBBI issues in Manitoba. The Network is supported by Nine Circles Community Health Centre which serves as its backbone support agency. The Network hosts two large events per year, one in November and one in April which brings together approximately 80 people from across the Province of Manitoba representing a variety of regions and stakeholders (people with lived experience, researchers, policy makers, community organizations, health providers, Indigenous organizations, health authorities, etc) These meetings are highly interactive engaging meetings that do many things including building relationships, sharing knowledge, engagement in deliberative dialogues and involve a number of engaging facilitation techniques. As a result of COVID-19, we now need to move to a virtual facilitation and would like to maintain a high level of engagement as we have at our face to face meetings.

One of our priorities is to ensure that we are able to engage PEERS in the process with our new virtual event to be held November 20, 2020.

SCOPE OF WORK

The PEER Engagement Coordinator will work with the project team to assist with best engagement strategies for PEERS who are attending the November event. They will assist with planning for engagement, recruitment of a PEER group, coordinating the computer technologies prior to the event, assisting with the orientation for the PEER group, coordinating and managing and assisting the PEER group on the day of the event in Winnipeg, assisting with PEER hubs outside of Winnipeg, and assisting with the follow-up evaluation. One of the PEER Event Facilitator's main task is to ensure that the PEER group feels comfortable and engaged.

TIMEFRAME OF THE POSITION

This position is expected to begin October 19, 2020 and end Dec 31, 2020. The event is to held November 20, 2020.
