Required time: Variable- based on event needs

Duties: Support Nine Circles activities at community events including: The Red Ribbon Walk & Run, Pride Winnipeg, Sexual Health Awareness Week and World AIDS Day. Roles depend on the event.

Pride: Work a shift at our information booth at the Forks, handing out safer sex supplies and resources, or help create a float for the Pride Parade.

Red Ribbon Walk & Run: set up/take down, registration, food/snacks table, volunteer hospitality, kids area, walk marshals, answer participant questions etc.

- Help out with event preparations
- With certain events, there may be an opportunity to sit on a planning committee
- When volunteer shifts require additional training, instruction will be provided prior to your shift. Event volunteer shifts may require attendance at a volunteer info session prior to the event.

At Each Shift:

- When you arrive, sign in as instructed. At the end of shift, sign out.
- If you can't make it to a planned shift, please call/email and let the Community Engagement Coordinator know.
