Job Summary

Under the direction of the Director of Primary Care, and the supervision of the medical director, the Physician's Assistant (PA) or Clinical Assistant (CA) respectfully works with diversity including sexual and gender minorities, and across all ethnicities and cultural, spiritual, political, age, ability, family and economic circumstances. Using a culturally safe, client centered, strength based, and harm reduction approach and with an emphasis on providing HIV/sexually transmitted and blood borne infection (STBBI) care, the PA/CA will collaborate with physicians to provide competent primary care.

As part of the interdisciplinary team, the PA/CA works collaboratively to provide professional, evidence-informed, holistic care within a low barrier clinic environment. As part of a primary care team, their care may include assessment, diagnostic testing, diagnosis, clinical intervention and treatment, health promotion and care planning, prescribing, minor procedures, and follow-up.

As full-time, the position is 80 hours per two-week period. The regular workdays for this position will fall between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Mondays through Fridays. Occasional weekends may be required.

This position is covered by the Collective Agreement between Physician and Clinical Assistants of Manitoba (PCAM) and the Winnipeg Employers Organization. A comprehensive benefit package is provided as per employee eligibility via HEB Manitoba.

Qualifications

- Provider Basic Life Support

Physician Assistants:

- Must be eligible for College of Physician's and Surgeon's Manitoba physician assistant as a regulated associate member:
- A graduate from the Physician Assistant Education Program at the University of Manitoba, Max Rady College of Medicine.
- Or be a graduate of a physician assistant training program accredited by the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant (ARC-PA) in the United States, and have passed the examination set by the NCCPA, and hold the designation "PA-C"
- Or graduated from another physician assistant training program approved by the Council.

Clinical Assistants:

- Must be a graduate of an accredited Medical School in Canada or abroad and must have at least one of the following:
- Registered Clinical Assistant Assessment offered by the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences, Max Rady College of Medicine, University of Manitoba.
- National Assessment Collaborative Objective Structured Clinical Examination (NAC OSCE).
- Satisfactory completion of the Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC).

Preferred Education and Certifications

- Addictions and Mental Health training and certifications

Knowledge, Skills, and Experience

- Minimum 3 years of experience in primary care. Preference will be given to those with clinical experience in fast paced and independent practice settings such as emergency departments, mental health and crisis services, intensive care units and northern nursing stations
